circulation policies

Undergraduate students may borrow up to 25 books at one time. The loan period is for 3 weeks. Students must show a current NMSU ID card. Crimson Scholars are eligible to check out materials for the entire semester. In addition, any permanent New Mexico resident can check out a total of 5 books at any one time from the NMSU Libraries. general services

- **Library Express:** Materials can be obtained from the collections of any NMSU Library and delivered to the student's location via courier.
- **Information Delivery Services (IDS):** This is the new name for InterLibrary Loan, Pegasus Delivery, and Pick-up Services. These complementary services combine to provide NMSU faculty and students access to needed research information whether owned by the library or another organization.
- **UTEP Agreement:** Those with a current NMSU ID card are allowed to borrow books directly from UTEP simply by presenting the card. Books may then be returned at NMSU Libraries or at UTEP.
- **Photocopiers:** The NMSU Libraries have photocopy machines available in many locations in both libraries. Copies are 10¢ per page or 8¢ per page when purchasing a copy card.
- **Computer Clusters:** Work processing is available on the 2nd and 3rd floors of Zuhl Library and the 2nd floor of Branson Library. Computers with Internet capabilities are also available in both libraries.

electronic resources

- **Online Library Catalog:** A Web-based library catalog with access to all NMSU library collections.
 - **netLibrary:** Provides access to almost 5,500 books in the sciences, social sciences, humanities and business.
 - **FirstSearch:** A variety of full-text databases and indexes including WorldCat, ERIC, MEDLINE, PsycINFO, WilsonSelectPlus, and many others.
 - **Additional Online Resources:** Includes access to SciSearch, Lexis-Nexis, Electronic Journals, and many others.
 - **Internet Access:** Search the Internet using *Netscape Navigator* or *Internet Explorer*.

periodicals/microforms

- **Finding magazines, journals, and newspapers:** Each library building has a periodicals area where current journals, newspapers, and magazines are kept. They are arranged in call number order.
 - **Finding older periodicals:** Some of the older periodicals are bound. They are then shelved in the stacks with the books. Other older periodicals may be on microfilm or microfiche and are located in the periodical department. They are also arranged in call number order.

special collections

- **Codes & Standards:** A repository for state, county, and municipal technical codes and standards. Located in Branson Library.
 - **Government Documents:** Materials published by the U.S. Government. Located on the 2nd floor in Branson Library.
 - **Map Collection:** Contains NM topographic maps as well as atlases. Located in Branson Library.
 - **Special Collections/Archives:** Contains the Library's rare and unique published materials. Located in Branson Library.
