

Technology Requirements for Program:

- The program courses will require you to view and or edit PDFs., Word Documents, Power Points, and Excel Spreadsheets. You will also require to access web-links and complete interactions e.g. Near Pod Learning Platform.
- The program delivers didactic/lecture content using a hybrid HYFLEX method. HyFlex is a course design model that presents the components of hybrid learning in a flexible structure that gives students the option of attending sessions in the classroom, participating online, or doing both (please see your course instructor for more details). To successfully participate, you will need the following technology:
 - A consistent, reliable Wi-Fi and internet connection
 - DACC offers free Wi-Fi for students in the East Mesa and Espina campus parking lots
 - Your NMSU ID and Password to log into Canvas and access course content.
 - Microsoft 365
 - Microsoft 365 is free for students. You can locate and download the software @ <https://studenttech.nmsu.edu/microsoft-office-365-pro-plus/> (Links to an external site.)
 - A device (computer, table or phone) which can play audiovisual content (i.e. videos)
 - A device with a webcam/camera for any live Zoom meetings. You can download Zoom for free @ <https://learning.nmsu.edu/zoom-at-nmsu/> (Links to an external site.) or find the Zoom link and instructions on the left side menu bar of any of your Canvas course pages.
- Adobe Acrobat Reader (recommended), which you can download for free @ <https://get.adobe.com/reader/>
- An iPad. This iPad should be able to:

 - Allow you to access and use Canvas and other required software programs
 - Have a working webcam/camera and microphone for live Zoom meetings.
