

Required Program Costs (Estimated)

- Immunizations- PPD (TB must be done yearly), MMR, Tdap, Varicella, Hepatitis B series (costs depends on student's insurance)
- Titers for MMR, Varicella, Hepatitis B (cost depends on student's health insurance)
- Current Health Insurance (price varies; students may qualify to remain on their parent's insurance, NMSU offers student insurance, or you may find a good deal privately as well).
- TEAS test (required to apply to the program, approx. \$60)
- Background Check and Drug Screen: must be repeated in each year of the program (approx. \$110 x 2)
- CPR course (approx. \$45)
- Tuition <https://dacc.nmsu.edu/admissions/dacc-tuition-rates-fees.html>
- Textbooks (approx. \$750)
- Uniforms: 5 scrubs, 2 lab coats, 2 pairs shoes, name tag, shoulder patches and ID markers (approx. \$300-500)
- Instadose dosimetry badge \$240
 - replacement dosimetry badge if damaged \$30
- Graduation fees (approx. \$25)
- National Certification Fees ARRT exam (approx. \$250)
- Temporary state licensing fees after graduation (good for one year): NM \$60, TX \$103
