



DACC to NMSU Transfer Checklist

Minimum requirements to transfer from DACC to NMSU-Las Cruces or NMSU Global:

- Earn a minimum 2.0 cumulative grade point average
 - Complete a minimum of 24 college credits
 - Complete CCDE 110N or be eligible to enroll in ENGL 1110G
 - Complete CCDM 114N or be eligible to enroll in MATH 1215 or MATH 1130G
