

Multiple measures approach for placement into English courses

The primary measure used for English courses will be high school GPA. Students who don't meet the GPA cutoff score are eligible to enroll in English 1110G if they meet any of the test scores listed in the secondary measure. If GPA and test score fall below the cutoff or are not available, alternative measures can be used to admit students into English 1110G.

Alternative Measures: HS English Grades and English Placement Survey	(If scores or GPA are below cutoff or scores are not available) High School Transcript: English course grades= B or higher (Junior and Senior years) <u>and</u> student answered mostly As on English Placement Survey

CCDE 110 Placement Guidelines (if not eligible for English 1110G)

CCDE 110/ENGL 1110G (Integrated)	Most recent high school English grades= C or above <u>and</u> answered A on English Placement Survey questions 5 and 6
CCDE 110	Any student can start here
