❑ REGISTER FOR COURSES

On the web at my.NMSU.edu or meet with your advisor, then visit

Have your NMSU Student ID Number ready and ask for a printout of your class schedule/fee statement. Make sure you note the payment amount and deadline.

❑ MEMORIZE YOUR STUDENT ID NUMBER

For security reasons, all students are issued an NMSU ID Number, which is nine digits long (like a social security number). Student services offices at DACC will ask you for this number as an identifier. The NMSU ID Number is also on the Student ID card.

❑ LEARN YOUR NMSU USERNAME AND PASSWORD

It is essential that you remember your NMSU username and password for your my.NMSU.edu account. All official communication from the college will be emailed to you at this email account only! Through this online account you can: Register Online • View your Schedule • Check Your Grades • Access the Class Schedule • Make payments to DACC/NMSU • Access STAR Degree Audits to learn what courses you need for your degree • Check your Financial Aid, and more!

❑ EXPLORE THE STAR DEGREE AUDIT SYSTEM

Did you know that the STAR degree audit system is like a roadmap? It can help you identify what courses you need to take to earn your degree, and shows how far you have progressed toward your goal! Access this from the link in your mynmsu, and take a copy with you to your next academic advising appointment!

❑ KNOW THE SELECTION PROCESS

If you plan to pursue a degree in a **competitive admission program** (Such as many of our health and apprenticeship programs) it is **very important** to be aware of the entrance requirements early on. For apprenticeship program requirements, refer to the current DACC Catalog or contact the Technical and Industrial Studies Division at 527-7590.

❑ STAY IN TOUCH WITH YOUR ACADEMIC ADVISOR
