Create your FSA ID

- Go to studentaid.gov and create an account for Student and Parent.
- Parents without a SSN can now create an FSA ID.

- Forgot your FSA ID username or password? Reset on studentaid.gov and select forgot username/password.

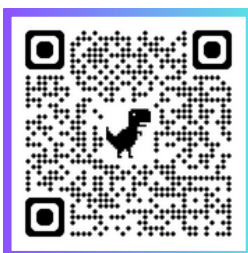


What will I need to complete my FAFSA application?

- Your Social Security Number
- Your A-Number (if you're not a U.S. citizen)
- Bank statements and records of investments (if applicable), net worth of investments, businesses, and farms
- Records of untaxed income (if applicable)
- Federal income tax returns, records of child support received; and your current balance of cash, savings, and checking accounts (Note: You must provide consent and approval to disclose your federal tax information to be eligible for federal student aid.)
 - 2023 Taxes for FAFSA 2025-2026 - Fall 25, Spring 26, Summer 26
 - 2024 Taxes for FAFSA 2026-2027 - Fall 26, Spring 27, Summer 27- Opens Oct 1, 2025.

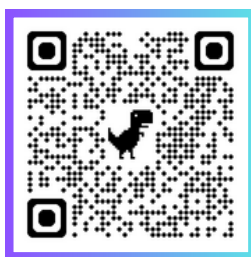

Get your Tax Record

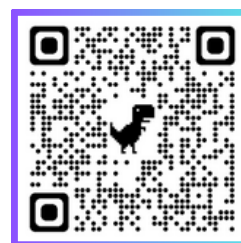


- Request Online <https://www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript> - View, print, or download your transcript

- Review the identity authentication requirements before attempted to register with the IRS.

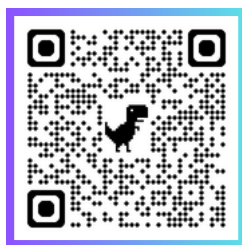

FINANCIAL AID CHECKLIST

☐ **COMPLETE THE FAFSA AND SCHOLAR DOLLAR\$ BY MARCH 1ST**

For priority consideration for work-study, grants, and scholarships, students should submit the FAFSA and Scholar Dollar\$ by March 1st. Students can still submit these applications after the deadline.

☐ **RECEIVE FINANCING PLAN FROM NMSU FINANCIAL AID**

Each year, after you've filed a FAFSA, you will receive a letter that reviews your tentative awards and student budget for the academic year. Keep in mind that any awards offered are tentative until all requirements are satisfied. Award amounts will change based on your enrollment.

☐ **VIEW AWARD AND REQUIREMENTS ON MYNMSU**

Login to NMSU <https://my.nmsu.edu//>

After you have received your Financing Plan, you will be able to log on to your myNMSU account to view your Financial Aid Status. If you have any financial aid requirements, you'll also find them on your myNMSU.

☐ **ACCEPT THE FINANCIAL AID TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

All students must accept the Financial Aid Terms and Conditions each year before they can receive their financial aid awards. Log on to your myNMSU to accept the Terms and Conditions

☐ **ACCEPT OR DECLINE LOANS AND WORK-STUDY**

If you were awarded loans or work-study, you may accept or decline these awards on myNMSU. We strongly encourage you to accept or decline these awards right after the semester begins

☐ **COMPLETE LOAN ENTRANCE COUNSELING AND A MASTER PROMISSORY NOTE**

If you accepted loans, complete Entrance Counseling and sign a Master Promissory Note (MPN). These requirements can be found at studentaid.gov/manage-loans.

☐ **REVIEW AWARD AND REQUIREMENTS ON MYNMSU**

Check your myNMSU account to make sure all your financial aid requirements are satisfied.

☐ **SETUP DIRECT DEPOSIT**

Select Student Tab on Home page - A new pop-up screen will appear- Student Service Menu
Under Student Service Profile- Go to Student Account and Payment Information
Select Direct Deposit Sign up.

☐ **CHECK EMAIL REGULARLY**

Financial Aid and UAR, as well as other offices, will provide updates and notices via the myNMSU email.
